Project Greenlight 3 Top 10 Director Scene Assignment Instructions

The scene is written to be as ambiguous as possible as to tone, character, gender, setting, circumstances, etc.

Contestants must select 2 of the 3 pages, combine them in the order of their choosing and shoot a single short film between 3 and 5 minutes in length. Additionally, you must add OR select dialog as prompted. Otherwise, the script must be played verbatim; however, pace - pauses, mumbles, gesticulations - are entirely up to you.

It is entirely up to you to decide how many characters are interacting in the scenes, how many locations are used, how many scenes you break the dialogue into, and whether or not the scenes are related or completely standalone. The only requirement is that at least one character must communicate all of the lines in the script. It's up to you whether the lines are spoken, titled, in a foreign language, in slang. But ONLY the lines listed may be used and ALL lines must be used.

Items underlined and italicized are for you to select (for example: if the script has "he/she goes outside" it's up to you to decide whether this will read "he goes outside," or "she goes outside"). You must select and use one of the offered choices.

You MAY NOT use any music (whether pre-recorded or your own performance) in your scene.

We'd like you to be creative and inventive. The scenes can be funny, scary, tense, sad, some combination of these or whatever you like...we look forward to seeing what you come up with.

THIS SCENE IS YOUR CHANCE TO SET YOURSELF APART FROM THE REST OF THE CONTESTANTS, SO MAKE THE MOST OF IT.

IMPORTANT: Please be sure to stay within the exact parameters of the assignment, especially where we're asking for you to fill in dialog. Make sure you select from the choices and ONLY from the choices. Your scene will be subject to disqualification if you violate the rules, even if we love your work.

PLEASE READ THIS IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT THE TOP 10 DIRECTOR SCENE ASSIGNMENT:

The Top 10 Scene (and/or Alternate, as applicable) must be made strictly in accordance with the guidelines ("Top 10 Scene Guidelines") set forth above. Please note that Project Greenlight will not view any portion of any Top 10 Scene Assignment that exceeds five (5) minutes in length, and that the inclusion of any additional material, including, without limitation, any mention or identification of the name, title, concept, idea, or content of your Submission, or any deviation from the Top 10 Guidelines, will subject you (and your Team, as applicable) to disqualification. You hereby irrevocably assign to Project Greenlight all rights, title, and interest (including, without limitation, all copyright) in and to your Top 10 Scene, and you acknowledge and agree that Project Greenlight shall own all intellectual property rights (including, without limitation, all copyright) in and to your Top 10 Scene. You further acknowledge that your Top 10 Scene will be reviewed by Project Greenlight as a factor in determining your future participation in the Contest, and that, as owner of the Top 10 Scene, Project Greenlight shall have the right (but not the obligation) to use all or part of your Top 10 Scene on the Project Greenlight website, in the Project Greenlight Series, in the Project Greenlight Film, or in any other manner or medium (whether now known or hereafter devised) in perpetuity and throughout the Universe, in Project Greenlight's sole discretion. In connection therewith, Promoter shall have the right, in its sole discretion, to edit, composite, morph, scan, duplicate, or alter, your Top 10 Scene Assignment for

any purpose which Promoter deems necessary or desirable, and you hereby irrevocably waive any and all so-called moral rights you may have in the Top 10 Scene. You hereby consent to Promoters' use of your name, image, likeness, on-camera performance, and all other indicia of your persona for any purpose whatsoever as described in this Agreement and/or in the Official Rules and the Participation Agreement, all without any compensation to you.

Of course.

So should we get down to it?

CHARACTER

First tell me what you think of this?

CHARACTER

I don't know what to say.

CHARACTER

What's your opinion?

CHARACTER

[HIS/HER/YOUR/MY/THEIR/ITS]
opinion?

CHARACTER

Why not?

CHARACTER

I don't know.

CHARACTER

Try.

CHARACTER

[7 WORD OR LESS RESPONSE]

CHARACTER

Why?

CHARACTER

It's just an opinion.

CHARACTER

You think?

CHARACTER

[7 WORD OR LESS RESPONSE]

CHARACTER

Hard to argue with that.

CHARACTER

What [ARE, AM, IS] [I, YOU, WE, HE, SHE, THEY, THAT, IT] doing?

CHARACTER

[7 WORD OR LESS RESPONSE]

CHARACTER

No.

CHARACTER

What else?

CHARACTER

Will it work?

CHARACTER

[YES, NO, MAYBE]

CHARACTER

If it [DOES, DOESN'T]?

CHARACTER

[7 WORD OR LESS RESPONSE]

CHARACTER

That's reassuring.

CHARACTER

Look.

CHARACTER

It's that simple.
